YUMMY Project

What?

A program for the professional and social integration of young people aged 18 to 24, in highly precarious situations and deeply affected by exclusion, in the Malvani slum in northern Mumbai, India.

The Life Project Centers recently set up nearby support young people up to their socio-professional integration and are becoming genuine incubators for entrepreneurial projects.

How?

By combining entrepreneurial experience and intensive coaching in an 18-month educational project, including a 6-month work placement.

By developing the skills of young people, which are essential for revealing their professional potential (English, IT, accounting, technical management of a company)

Why?

To enable young people to re-integrate socially and professionally

Duration of support

1 year (2018) by a re-evaluation of the program
