- Provide young people in the community with a learning program to promote their integration into society and the workplace.

The project developed by Thien An Home II aims to help ethnic minority children and adolescents by providing them with good nutrition and a learning and health prevention program. It gives the beneficiaries every opportunity to integrate society by being able to seek care, follow a school curriculum and ultimately obtain work. It also trains families of this minority in farming and breeding techniques to help them meet their daily needs.

How?

- By providing youth and their families with balanced meals to raise their awareness of good health and nutrition
- By teaching children to cook garden-fresh vegetables and make their own bread
- By providing them with medical coverage through local health insurance

Why?

The likelihood of workplace success for members of this ethnic minority community is reduced from the outset. By enabling them to develop their knowledge, skills and autonomy for better nutrition and health, Thien An Home II gives these children and their families all the keys they need to succeed.
