Information Required in Growing Season on Roquette Contracted Acres:

• Proof of Certified Seed Use – copy of invoice from seed grower, or seed tag that shows variety purchased, bushels or kg purchased and where seed was bought. Can be submitted as a picture or as a scanned document – required by July 23, 2021. Can be emailed to <u>Anastasia</u> <u>Kubinec</u>.

Environmental Farm Plan – Certificate of Completion. Can be submitted as a picture or as a scanned document – required by July 23, 2021. Can be emailed to <u>Anastasia Kubinec</u>.

UPDATE: Portage Pea Protein Plant

The Portage la Prairie pea protein plant started operations as planned, at the end of 2020.

To date, we have picked up hundreds of loads of peas from growers, and we are using these peas to fine-tune and commission our processing and quality assurance systems at the plant.

Our goal is to have consumer-ready protein available during the summer of 2021, and the plant will reach full production capacity in early 2022. Roquette in Canada has hired 110 people to date and at capacity will employ 120 people.

AGRONOMY SUPPORT AND INFORMATION

<u>Time to Check Your Bins</u> – Moving from cold temperatures to warm temperatures, condensation that has developed or snow in your bin has melted and can be causing spoilage. Check the grain peaks to see make sure no fungal/bacterial growth or sprouting has started.
